

Central Professional Improvement Committee Report

Thursday February 11, 2016

Reminders:

- Ideally, each school should have a functioning DPIC, with a chairperson responsible for the budget, and the committee responsible to drawing up guidelines that may be particular to the individual school. Any teacher is allowed to be on this committee. The guidelines for each DPIC committee can and should be reviewed on an annual basis, because the situation in the school can change from year to year. The DPIC committee is responsible for the guidelines at each school. They are mandated with distributing funds according to these guidelines.
- In cases where the school does not have a functioning committee, all PIC matters are instead brought to Staff Council. At staff council meetings, the DPIC should report the current accounting, as best it can be estimated at the time, as well as future plans for DPIC funds.
- The Central PIC does not want to interfere with school-based committee decisions, as each school has their particularities. That said, DPIC guidelines should not be in opposition to CPIC guidelines, which are detailed in the handbook.
