New teachers fund

A memo has been sent to new teachers to inform them that they can apply directly to the Central Professional Improvement Committee. Online courses will not be covered by this program; however, the DPIC may decide to cover a new teacher for an online class.

CPIC Forms

The new forms can be found on SSO and the handbook will be available as well, as soon as the numbers are official.

Staff Council

A discussion took place regarding reporting to staff council. It is important that DPIC reports to staff council events that were approved as well as the local guidelines established by the DPIC.

In cases where a school/centre does not have a DPIC, staff council needs to make the decisions and act as the committee.

Adult Education - Hourly paid teachers

CPIC does not reimburse hourly-paid teachers for their university courses. However, each DPIC may decide to fund credit courses.

Review of requests

The committee reviewed 19 credit courses applications. All but one were approved, which was refused as it was for summer 2016. It is important for teachers to send in the information prior to taking the course.

22 PDA events were presented. All were approved.
